DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that Martin Luther not only translated the Bible into German but also used the printing press to spread his translation and ideas widely? Before the Reformation, the Bible was only available in Latin, a language most people couldn't

read. Luther believed everyone should have access to God's Word, so he translated the New Testament into German, making Scripture understandable for everyday people. He then used the relatively new invention of the printing press to mass-produce copies, allowing his translation and Reformation teachings to spread rapidly across Europe. This revolutionary combination of translating and printing helped ensure that God's Word could reach more people than ever before. Today, Lutheran schools continue this legacy by teaching students to engage with Scripture and use modern tools to share the Gospel!
