“PIE TIME” is an initiative designed to encourage greater family involvement and support in school activities and programs. This ultimately creates a stronger and more engaged school community.

### “PIE TIME” VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES COULD INCLUDE:

- Room Parents
- Time spent volunteering at school events
- Field trip driver/chaperone
- Serving on boards or committees within Trinity Lutheran School/Church
- Time spent outside of the classroom on special projects
- Coaching or refereeing at TLS sporting events
- Other opportunities arranged with your child’s teacher or the PTL officers

## INTRODUCING “PIE TIME”

### Parents, Our PARTNERS IN EDUCATION

At the start 2024-2025 school year, we ask each family to complete volunteer hours based on their oldest child's age:

- Preschool: 2 hours per quarter (8 hours per year)
- K-8th Grade: 4 hours per quarter (16 hours per year)

The quarters are divided as follows:

- QTR 1: August - October
- QTR 2: November - January
- QTR 3: February - March
- QTR 4: April - May

Beginning August 2025, these volunteer requirements will be mandatory.
